

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries are free and open to Members of Societies affiliated with the Orchid Society of NSW Ltd.
2. All exhibits to be benched in the **MANNING UNITING CHURCH COMPLEX, ALBERT STREET** between 5.00pm and 6.30pm on Thursday 24th August 2023.
3. The Society shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or destruction of any exhibit. An exhibitor shall not have any claim whatsoever against the Society.
4. Judging will be in accordance with the standards laid down by the Australian Orchid Council. The judges' decision shall be final.
5. Plants competing for prizes must be owned and in the possession of the exhibitor for the 6 months preceding the show.
6. No exhibit may be removed from the show before the termination of the show without permission of the Show Marshall.
7. All plants exhibited must be healthy and free from pests and diseases. Diseased plants will be rejected. The Show Marshall's decision in the matter will be final.
8. All staging of exhibits shall be under the direction of the Show Marshall.
9. Foliage plants are plants that are not in flower. Any plants flowers other than orchids will be rejected with the exception of Anthuriums and Bromeliads.
10. Each plant shall be clearly labeled by the exhibitor showing the exhibitor's number and class number.
11. A Novice shall be a member of the Manning River Orchid Society Inc and shall satisfy the conditions of The Orchid Society of NSW Ltd to be classified as such.
12. A Junior shall be a member of The Manning River Orchid Society Inc and shall satisfy the conditions of The Orchid Society of NSW Ltd to be classified as such.
13. Extra classes may be created at the discretion of the Committee.
14. A seedling is the whole of the clone flowering for the first time (as defined by The Australian Orchid Council).
15. Unless otherwise stated the Orchid Classes 1 to 29 are for hybrids only.
16. The society shall not be liable to exhibitors for any promised prize money or voucher, should a sponsor withdraw a promise.
17. The sale of plants is only open to exhibiting financial members of the Manning River Orchid Society Inc or at the discretion of the committee.
